

## JUDO NEW ZEALAND

### **2012 National Training Camp for Cadets, Juniors and Seniors**

**(NB: This camp is compulsory for National Squad Members who wish to be considered for the NZ Team to the OJU Championships in April, 2012 unless prior dispensation has been given to individuals by their squad coach)**

**DATES:** Friday 17<sup>th</sup> of Feb from 6.00 pm until Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> at approx. 2.00 pm. (There will be training on Friday evening from 7.00 pm)

**VENUE:** Wanganui Boys and Girls Club, Springvale Park, G F Mo0re Drive, Wanganui

**INVITED: Category 1 (High Priority)** – All National Squad Members (Athletes who earned ranking points in 2 or more points events over the last 12 months – see Points Ranking List on the JNZ website NB Current PRL on the website is upto and including the Nationals.

**NB: Cadet & Junior National Squad Members are required to stay at the camp. Seniors can elect to participate under Category 3 below**

**Category 2** - Other registered athletes with a minimum of 3<sup>rd</sup>kyu

**Category 3** - Senior National Squad Members who are not staying at the camp or being provided with meals

**ADDITIONAL NOTES:**

1. All applicants must be registered with Judo NZ when applying to and attending the camp.
2. Accommodation: Spaces are limited and applications received after the initial deadline of 3<sup>rd</sup> February, 2012, will be treated on a first come, first served basis, until all spaces are filled.
3. The training camp will be attended by the national coaches/selectors and the team to represent NZ at the 2012 OJU Championships will be selected after the training camp.
4. Registered coaches are invited to attend the camp at the nominal cost of \$ 80 (all inclusive if requiring accommodation and meals). Please indicate clearly on the application form, if the application is for a coach, as this will determine the sleeping arrangement.
5. Players attending the camp will be sent the camp programme and relevant forms after 3<sup>rd</sup> February, 2012.
6. Refund Policy: A player withdrawing from the camp may apply IN WRITING for a refund of camp fees paid, and must include documentation (eg medical certificate) to support the reasons given.

Any such complete application received after the cut-off date of 3<sup>rd</sup> February, 2012 may be entitled to a 50 % refund.

7. A bus (or van) will transport camp participants between Wanganui or Palmerston North Airports and the venue from 3.00 pm on Friday and after 2.00 pm on Sunday.
8. Those requiring transport from//to Wanganui or Palmerston North Airports must ensure that this is clearly shown on your application which must be received by the deadline on 3<sup>rd</sup> February, 2012.
9. All athletes must live up to the usual expectations of a high standard of behaviour. This includes the requirement that Juniors (and Cadets) refrain from alcohol-during the entire camp period.
10. WHAT TO BRING: - Sleeping bags, Pillow, togs (there may be time for a swim), judogis, plus the normal training gear including running/training shoes, tape etc.
